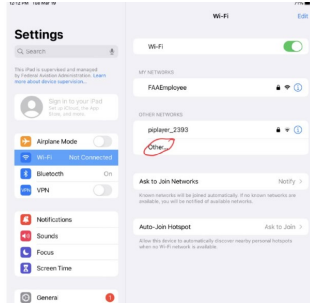


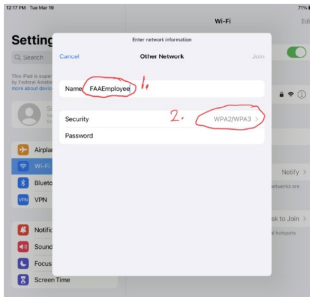
FAA WiFi Connection Instructions

These instructions are the same as the FAA Wifi Help Video on your iPad
This is only for FAA issued devices. Do not use for personal devices

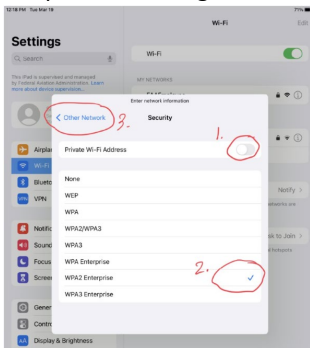
1. On your iPad, find and open the “Settings” app.
2. On the left, select “Wi-Fi”, and on the right side, select Other...



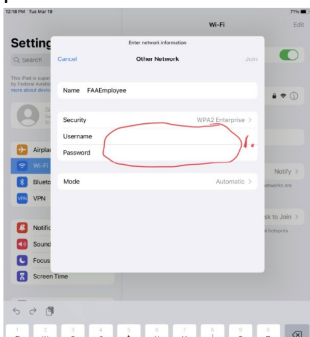
3. Type in “FAAEmployee” exactly. Do not select “FAAEmployee” from the list of available Wi-Fi networks. It will not work with the FAA credentials you need to enter. Then click “WPA2/WPA3” in the security box.



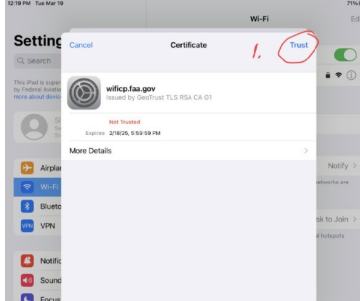
4. Turn off “Private Wi-Fi Address”, then select “WPA2 Enterprise”, then click “Other Network” to return to the previous dialog box.



5. Type in your Username which is your FAA Email ending with faa.gov, and your Active Directory/Email password. You should then be able to select Join.

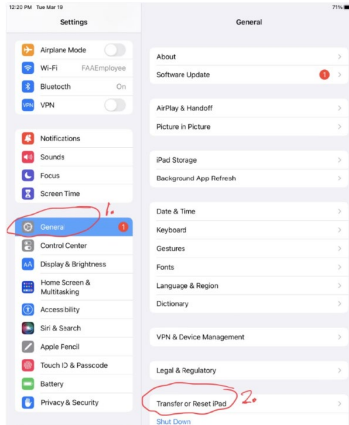


6. If everything went right, you'll be given a Certificate box you need to accept by clicking "Trust". If everything was done correctly, you will be on the FAA WiFi after a few seconds.

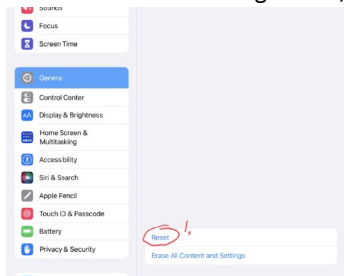


7. If you get a message "Could not join network", or it keeps booting you off, you need to Reset Network Settings by following the remaining instructions. If you stay on the Wi-Fi with no issues, you are done.

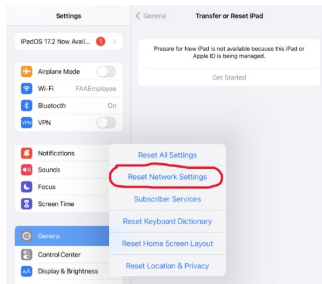
8. **RESET NETWORK SETTINGS:** In your "Settings" app, go to "General" on the left side and select it. On the right side, select "Transfer or Reset iPad".



9. At the bottom on the right side, select "Reset".



10. In the next window, click "Reset Network Settings". If a confirmation dialog pops up, select "OK" or "YES".



11. The iPad will reboot, log back into the iPad and restart this tutorial.
